- 2. We shared in the message some strong evidences of the resurrection of Jesus. Why do you think the skeptics and/or atheists want to disprove the resurrection of Jesus? Then, discuss the points of evidence and the critical factor each one plays.
- 3. There are several reasons why the resurrection of Jesus is so important for us believers. Which one speaks to you the most? Why?
- 4. Knowing that the resurrection of Jesus is a historical fact, what does this mean to you personally? How does this truth affect you, and what change in mindset or life choices is God asking you to make as a result?
